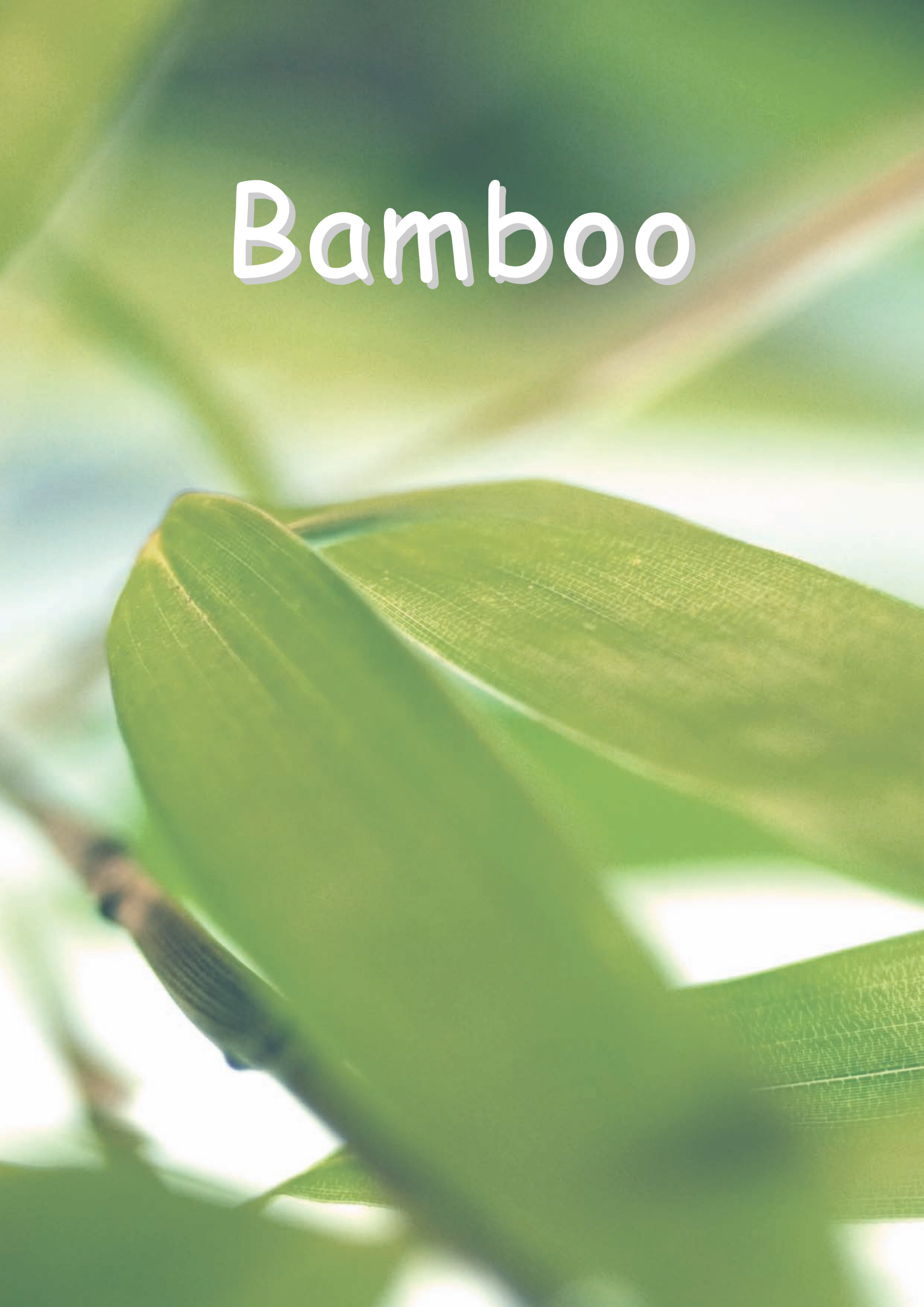

- Bamboo contains a unique, natural antibacterial bio-agent : bamboo-kun
- The textile research centre Centextbel Verviers, Belgium, certifies the antibacterial function of our bamboo yarns
- No pesticides are used during the cultivation of bamboo ; bamboo is naturally pest and pathogen resistant
- In 1879, Thomas Edison used bamboo as one of the first electric light bulb filaments. Bekaert Textiles has now shed light upon another bright idea for bamboo !

What are the benefits of using Bamboo in a mattress ?

- Bamboo has permanent and natural antibacterial properties (no chemicals needed)
- Bamboo offers higher moisture absorption than cotton
- Bamboo has a soft hand, a cool touch and a natural, silky luster
